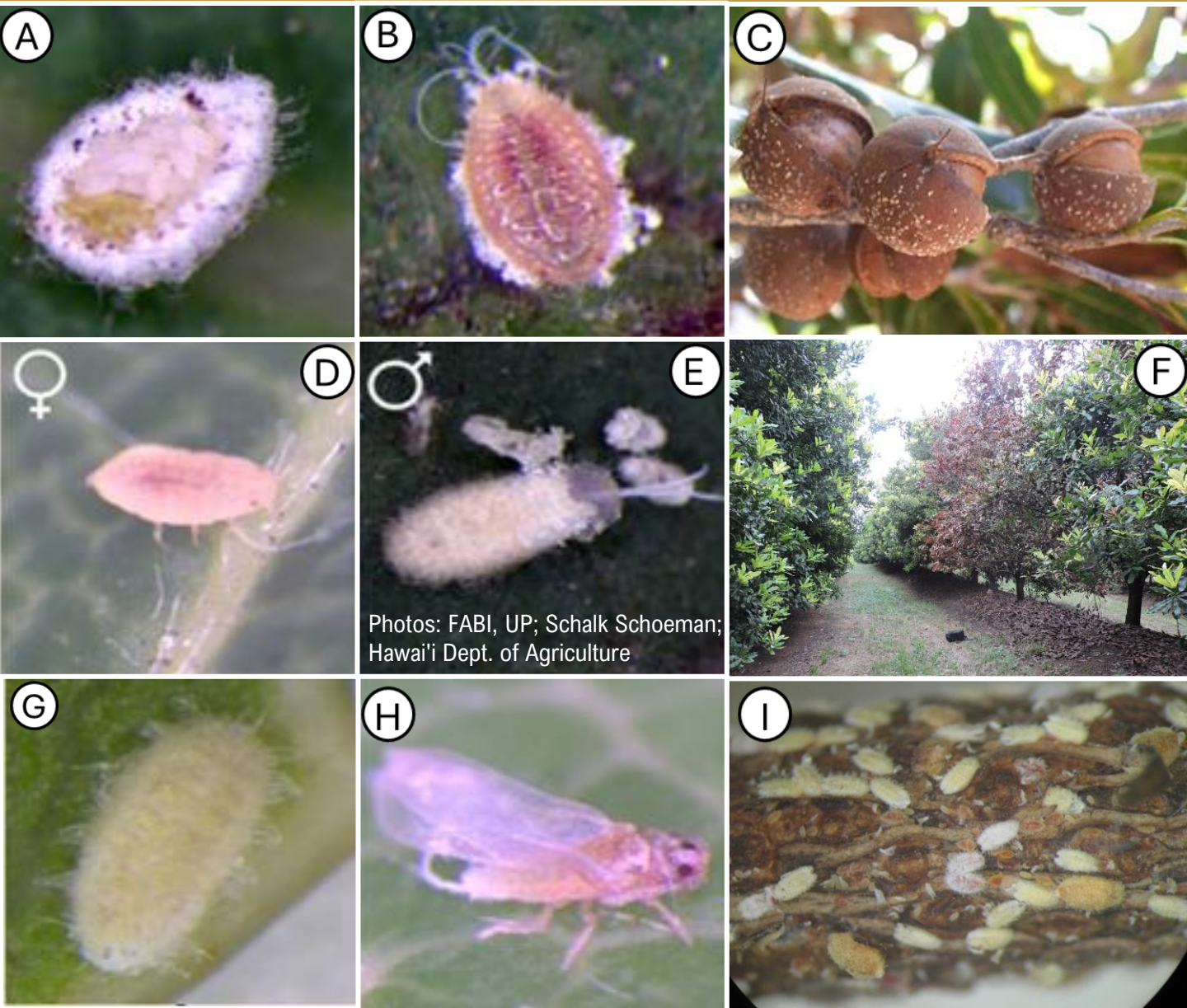


MACADAMIA FELTED COCCID

Known hosts: Macadamias.
Distribution: Australia; Mpumalanga.

- (A)** Eggs contained within felted sac.
- (B)** Young nymph.
- (C- D)** Adult females are wingless and form a felted sac when mature.
- (E – F)** Adult males have wings and do not form a felted sac.
- (G)** Infested nuts.
- (H)** Tree dieback associated with heavy infestations.
- (I)** Nymphs and females visible under a microscope.
