
MACADAMIA FELTED COCCID

Eriococcus ironesidei



Known hosts: Macadamias.

Distribution: Australia; Mpumalanga.

(A) Eggs contained withing felted sac.

(B) Young nymph.

(C- D) Adult females are wingless and form a felted sac when mature.

Adult males have wings and do not form a felted sac.

Infested nuts.

(E – F) (G) (H) (I) Tree dieback associated with heavy infestations.

Nymphs and females visible under a microscope.
