
## POLYPHAGOUS SHOTHOLE BORER

Highly polyphagous- wide range of woody trees and shrubs.

Cosmopolitan; throughout ZA but isolated.

Adult beetles are small (1-2mm in length) and black/dark brown.

Characteristic wood staining due to fungal symbiont infection.

Resin oozing from entrance holes.

Round entrance holes on woody stems (arrows).

Sugar volcano oozing from entrance holes due to boring activity.

Resin oozing and frass noodles protruding from entrance holes.

Characteristic dieback associated with fungal symbiont infection.
